Officers Meeting:

January 15th, 2006

Officer's term of office will run for one year, with no limit on the number of times they can be reelected to office (if they are willing to remain in office). If the members don't like an officer they can vote them out!

We have added three experienced driver/show people as director/advisors to the list of officers, who will henceforth be elected by the membership <u>after</u> this year's term.

Family memberships will include 4 people with voting privileges for those 18 years of age or older. If extra memberships are paid in a family they will also have voting rights if over 18 years old.

We will publish a newsletter once a month to keep members informed. Who ever is putting on an event should write up a story for the newsletter about said event, but any other versions of the story are definitely welcome and encouraged, for other points of view.

Deadline for articles will be the first of the month with a publish/mailing date of the 15th of each month.

General Club Rules:

NO alcohol or drugs

NO horseplay

Those under 18 MUST wear a helmet AND be accompanied in the cart/carriage by an ADULT driver.

Those over 18 are STRONGLY recommended to wear a helmet, but can sign a waiver choosing not to wear one.

At EVERY event drivers & navigators will need to sign a Liability & a Safety release.

If an event is held where we will be on a public road you should have a slow moving vehicle sign on the back of your cart/carriage.

Judges decisions ARE FINAL!

Dogs at events MUST be on leashes AND under control IF the event holder is allowing dogs at the event. (This will be a farm specific rule)

Any disciplinary actions will be the Presidents jurisdiction.

REFUNDS: if an event is cancelled (including the rain date) all monies will be refunded. If the show goes on (including the rain date and you can't make it, NO monies will be refunded)

ADS Rules (American Driving Society) will apply to this club. www.americandrivingsociety.org

We talked about having a \$5.00 50/50 raffle at events to help raise money for the club.

Amanda will make a checklist of items to see what members are interested in doing and pass it out at the Feb meeting.

A March trail drive at Tanglewood was discussed; Tommy will check into parking and authorization for a drive there, no date set yet. We will try to plan events 3 months ahead. Tommy talked to Tanglewood about holding an event there.... \$1800.00 with their staff doing everything. Tommy is waiting to hear the price if we do everything.

Members can attend all future Officers meetings, but cannot participate in any discussions.

Incident Report!

Why even 55 year olds should wear helmets!

It seems I had a VERY EXCITING day yesterday (Thursday Feb 2)! So exciting I don't remember at least 10 hours of it!!!!! I remember waiting for my friends Marilyn and Dena to show up, with Fancy tied to our trailer, then thinking Marilyn should pull further forward so that when we come home I would be better able to pull in with the trailer. This was about 10:00-10:30 am. I just this minute remembered them asking about gas on the way up to our ride and told them we would need it on the way home (so I must have been driving on the way up to Rock House to ride). The next thing I can truly say I remember is being inside a cat scan machine, everything in between is blank.

I think the first time I asked Jeff what time it was, he said 10:00 or 10:30 **pm** (that may not have been the first time I asked though!) I am told I got bucked off of Fancy then got back on and rode back to the trailer with Marilyn and Dena, but at the trailer they

realized something was wrong with me. I don't even remember riding, I'm not sure if a memory of going by the rock formations and the swinging bridge are of this ride or a previous ride. I just remember waiting for them to get here! I most definitely don't remember how we got home or to the hospital! Marilyn can't drive a stick shift so I am told Dena drove us home, then Jeff took me to (I think) Baptist Hospital. Jeff didn't ride with us since he had just had a kidney stone blasted on Tuesday and was afraid some of the particles would start moving. I know I drove Jeff nuts asking him the same questions over and over again last night and I think I remember Marilyn & Dena visiting me in the Emergency Room but I'm not REAL sure about that. I don't remember any of the ride ESPECIALLY NOT getting bucked off!!!!!

Marilyn I don't have Dena's e-mail or phone number so would you pass this on to her. Both of you THANK YOU SO MUCH for taking care of me. getting me home and taking care of Fancy (Jeff has told me at my numerous askings that you guys fed her for us). If both of you were really there at the hospital, (not a figment of my imagination) thank you again. Thank you Dena for driving us all home, the truck and trailer are still in our neighbors yard. Jeff will have to move it later! Jeff took the day off from work I guess I can't be trusted to be left alone right now, although I feel fairly coherent at the moment, I am typing this. We didn't get home until about 12:30 this morning. I guess I might not be driving in Faith's Valentine Drive this Sunday, we'll have to see. I haven't tested the cart since the seat was welded back on.....another story from last Thursday! (The welds broke loose as we were finishing our drive over at Tommy's to test the new positioning of my wheels and the repaired arm rest from the event at Tommy's on the 7th)

To ALL my Horse friends **WEAR A HELMET!!!!!!!**I honestly believe that is the only reason I am still here, even if I am still a bit confused! I am 55 years old and not afraid to be seen in a helmet. I truly believed it saved my life yesterday!


